Short Term Disability (STD)  A monthly benefit offered if you are not able to work for a period of time because of:  • A non-job-related injury, or  • Illnesses	Talk to your employer, Human Resources Department or your STD plan provider to see if this benefit is available to you.
Long Term Disability (LTD)  A monthly benefit offered if you need to be off work for a long period of time due to an illness that prevents you from working.	Talk to your employer, Human Resources Department or your LTD plan provider to see if this benefit is available to you.
