



What I Need Bring for My Surgery - A Checklist:

- Ontario Health Card
- Copy of Advanced Directives (if applicable)
- Glasses, hearing aids, and their containers
- Self-adhesive sanitary pads (gynecology procedure only)
- Contact information for the person who will drive you home

You MUST arrange to be escorted home from the hospital after surgery. Patients who fail to make these arrangements risk having their **procedure postponed**. You must not drive a motor vehicle, operate heavy machinery or make any financial/legal decisions for a minimum of 24 hours post operatively if your receive an anaesthetic.

Are you being admitted to hospital after your surgery? If so, you will also need:

- Socks, robe, slip-on slippers with non-skid bottoms
- Any special medical equipment (eg. walkers, canes, braces)
- Toothbrush (with cover), toothpaste, lip conditioner, deodorant
- Your favourite pillow or other comfort items (optional)
- Reading material (optional)
- A comfortable set of loose-fitting clothes
