The purpose of this tool is to ensure relevant ethical values are considered when decisions are made to respond to the pandemic.

In **Steps 1, 2, and 3** answer each guiding question with "Yes", "Partially", or "No". If a question does not apply, mark it "N/A". Justifications should be given in the "comments" column for any question where the answer is "Partially" or "No", but comments related to each question are encouraged.

If many of your answers are "Partially" or "No", this should prompt reconsideration or an ethics consultation.

In the first part of **Step 2**, use the values listed to appraise the options under consideration for responding to the problem requiring a decision.
