## Pediatric Ophthalmologist

We have openings for two qualified Pediatric Ophthalmologists at Lakeridge Health Oshawa. The Pediatric Ophthalmology Outpatient Clinic operates one day per week, with services provided including: follow-up examination for ROP screening post discharge from the NICU; 6- to 9-month-old visual screening of high-risk preterm infants; strabismus screening; and post-operative follow-up visits. One day/week of operating room time will be available at the Oshawa campus for strabismus surgery and pediatric extra-ocular procedures. These positions offer access to 0.5 days per week each in OR and the clinic.

The successful applicants must be eligible for licensure by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada.
