The patients that you will see will have a wide range of neuromuscular problems such as amputations, complex wounds, traumatic fractures, neuropathy, spasticity, spinal cord injury, strokes, and multiple sclerosis.

Physiatrists at Lakeridge Health function in a consultant role, as our robust, well-established hospitalist program functions as MRP for most medical and rehab patients. We have a 23-bed integrated rehabilitation unit, a 28-bed integrated stroke unit and a 26-bed geriatric rehabilitation unit. Our Ambulatory Rehabilitation Centre Physiatry Clinic includes an EMG clinic, post-stroke follow-up clinic, spasticity management clinic, and prosthetic clinic.
