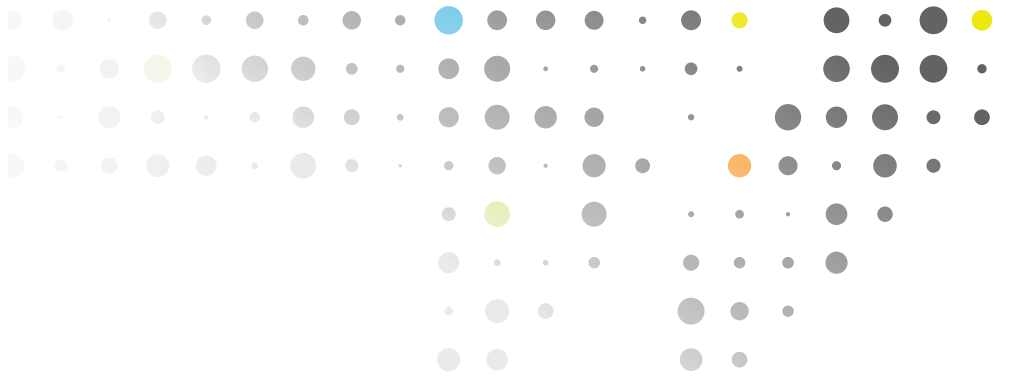

In 2020, Lakeridge Health forecasted a need for 1,000 beds. Patients are being treated in spaces not designed for the volume of patients or for patient care.

Near term critical capital investments are needed to meet growing demand and increase capacity at the Bowmanville Hospital and to build a new, modern greenfield hospital that is a big step forward in meeting growing acute care capacity needs over the next decade.

Durham Region’s population will be close to one million people in less than 20 years, and many will require specialized health-care services.

SENIORS**

Almost one third of the population is expected to be seniors aged 65 and older who will require more, and increasingly, complex care. This compares to the average in Ontario, which will be almost 22%. *

BED CAPACITY**

By 2041, Lakeridge Health will need 1,793 beds. That’s more than double the current count.

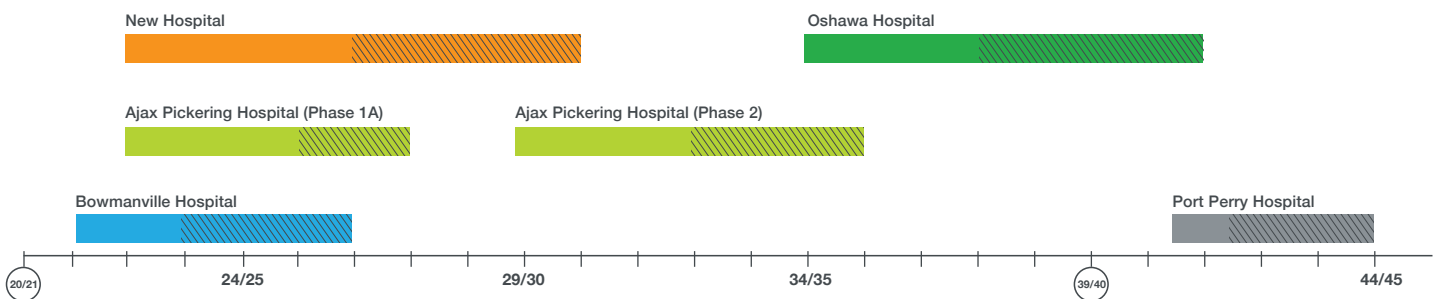
