Dr. Jason Pennington

Regional Indigenous Cancer Lead

Biography

Dr. Pennington is the Regional Indigenous Cancer Lead for the Central East Regional Cancer Program. He is a general surgeon with a special interest in proctology and colorectal surgery and currently works at the Scarborough Health Network. Dr. Pennington obtained both his undergraduate, medical and surgical degrees from the University of Toronto (U of T) where today, he is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Surgery. Recently he was a conference committee member of the Inaugural Indigenous Health Conference for the Continuing Education and Professional Development Program at U of T.

A member of the Huron-Wendat community of Wendake, Dr. Pennington has been active in the Aboriginal community with a strong focus on Aboriginal Health. Early roles included volunteering and tutoring in some of Toronto's Indigenous Organizations. Currently he is a member of the Indigenous Physicians Association of Canada (IPAC) and active on several committees including the Indigenous Health in Specialty Postgraduate Medical Education Steering Committee (RCPSC) and the Indigenous Health Conference organizing committee (U of T).

Dr. Pennington has also shared his expertise with Cancer Care Ontario (now Ontario Health) specifically supporting the Colon Cancer Check program as one of the physician leads for a pilot project to develop a Nurse Flexible Sigmoidoscopy Training Program. This program, designed to expand capacity for colorectal screening, won an Innovation in Health Care Award from the Ontario Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care. Subsequently, Dr. Pennington has advised both Cancer Care Ontario's Colorectal Cancer Screening Guideline Expert Panel and the FIT Implementation Committee.
