Job Purpose

Reporting to the Foundation CEO, the Director of Finance will be responsible for the financial program and systems of the Foundation including: (1) finance, (2) audit and compliance, (3) information and database systems, and (4) project management of special initiatives. The incumbent will supervise a team of two, including one direct report. The Director will also work closely with Lakeridge Health's Capital and Finance groups.

Job Responsibilities

Finance & Accounting

- Develops and supervises the Foundation's budget and business planning process.
- Oversees accounting processes, operating expenses and revenue reconciliation.
- Administrates disbursements and grants to Lakeridge Health, and liaises with medical and administrative directors for special designated funds.
- Works closely with the Foundations' external Money Manager reviewing performance including all endowed funds.
- Directs the capital budget for the Foundation.
- Ensures monthly and quarterly financial statements are complete and accurate.
- Monitors investment reports and compliance with investment policies.
- Provides input and direction on specialized financial reporting to Staff and board
- Attends Board, Finance and Investment meetings.
- Develops related policies and procedures.

Audit and Compliance

- Oversee annual financial audit in conjunction with the Finance and Audit Committee, and external auditors.
- Ensures all tax guidelines are adhered to and T3010 is filed accurately and on time.
- Ensures all legal and CRA requirements are met.

Information & Database Systems

- Evaluates and recommends hardware and software requirements.
- Determines allocation of new and existing computers and software for greatest efficiency.
- Directs database structure, coding, policies and procedures.
- Recommends database enhancements based on priorities of the Foundation.
- Oversees database management and staff training.

Staff Supervision

- Provides leadership and guidance to the financial team, and conducts performance evaluations.
- Ensures efficiency of workflows.
- Hires and trains administrative employees.

Project Management of Special initiatives

- Prioritizes and coordinates special projects as identified at a strategic level.
- Manages and coordinates specific initiatives, and communicates plans and outcomes to staff and volunteers.

General

- Promotes the Foundation's Mission within the Lakeridge Health and the community.
- Ensures all financial requests from the Board of Directors and volunteers are fulfilled.
- Is a member of the senior management of the Foundation.
- Communicates with all others in a helpful and respectful manner consistent with organizational values.
- Participates in team meetings.
- Performs other duties as assigned by the CEO.

QUALIFICATIONS

Required

- Experience in financial, and IS management within a service-oriented program.
- Strong leadership and supervisory skills, and operations accountability.
- Exceptional interpersonal skills, a collaborative style and effective communication at all levels.
- Strong knowledge of technology and computer systems.
- Proven experience working with databases at a strategic level.
- Familiarity with Canadian Not for Profit Corporations Act.
- Able to manage priorities of a team.
- Minimum of five years management experience.

Preferred

- A CPA designation and/or a University degree in accounting, commerce or business administration.
- Experience in a Canadian charity, and with Financial Edge and Raiser's Edge fundraising software.
