Update: Resident Outings in the Community

The safety of residents, families and staff is at the forefront of our decision-making, particularly during this pandemic.

As Durham Region moves into Phase 3, many families and residents have asked about the possibility of resident outings in the community. We always make every effort to accommodate residents and families' requests as much as possible, considering each resident's physical and mental health well-being. However, to protect the safety of residents, visitors and staff during the global pandemic, Ontario's Public Health guidelines continue to prohibit personal outings and trips for LTC homes and other congregate settings.

If your loved one has a medical appointment, please inform the nursing team so that a safe plan may be developed. We continue to monitor this dynamic situation and we will update you when this changes. We know this is an inconvenient and challenging time for all.

Update on Indoor Family Visits: Dedicate Lounges in Home Areas

We're happy to see so many families visiting their loved ones and appreciate how important the emotional and spiritual support of families and partners-in-care is for residents. For everyone's safety, indoor visits will continue to be assigned to dedicated lounges within each home area. Outdoor and virtual visits are also still available.
