RE: Spring CME 2016

The Spring CME will be starting in early March and it will run through into June. Please ensure that you are scheduled with your primary service to attend one of the dates in your area.

The CME day will start as it always does, with a medical directives quiz. As in the fall, you will have the ability to reference your hard copy pocketbook (but not your neighbor's and not an electronic version). You will again have 45 minutes to complete the quiz and enter it electronically through the clicker. Just like on a call, you need to watch your time. If you have concerns over test writing and the time constraint, please call us in advance of your CME day to discuss available options. In the unlikely event of a mark less than 70% on the quiz, you will be required to rewrite the quiz before the end of the day.

This CME is going to continue to build on less sitting and more doing! Following the quiz, you will break into groups to practice and perform infrequently used skills, run scenarios, take part in a table top MCI exercise and engage in a little gameplay.

As always, we will be posting some sample questions to help review for the "open book" quiz. The previously posted medical directive quiz questions can be found under the past CME tab. There will not be any CME content posted on the website for your review prior to attending as there are no formal in class presentations to be made this time.

Please remember to bring your own stethoscope (if you have one) for use during the day. As always, your attendance and successful completion of all components of the CME are a requirement of your maintenance of certification / authorization with the CEPCP and is an expectation of your patients.
