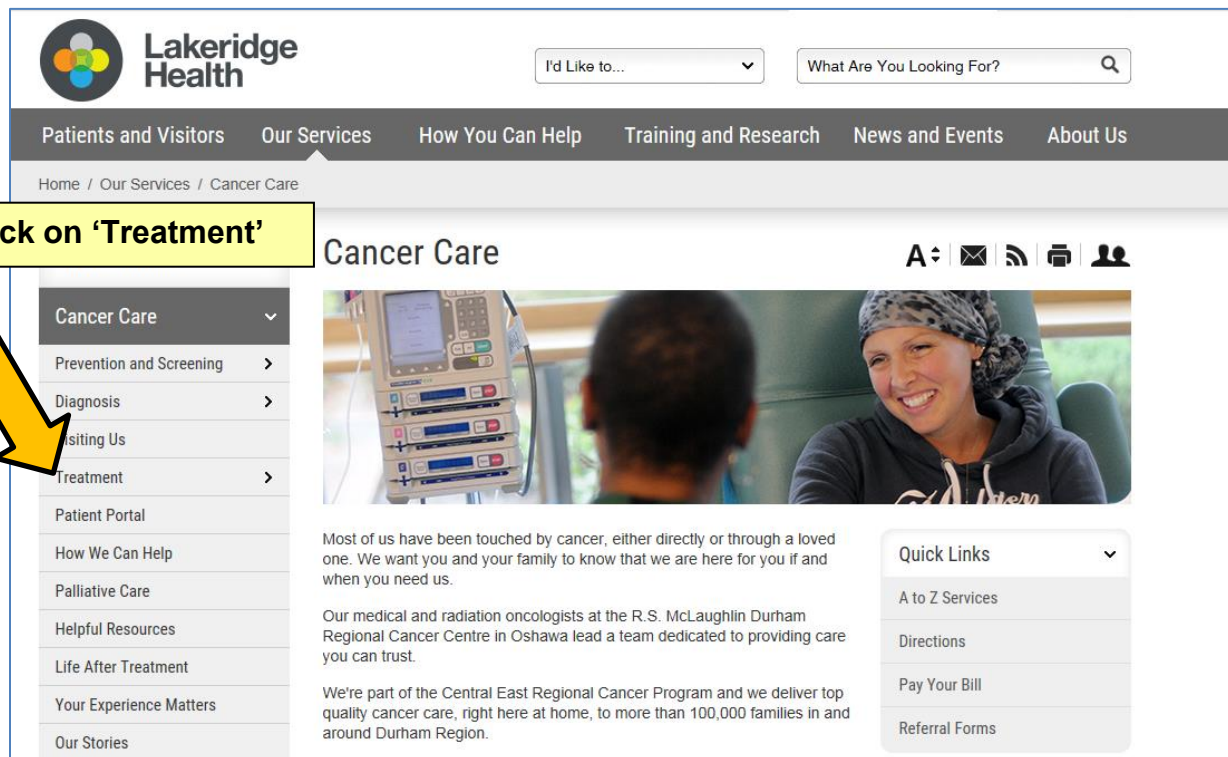
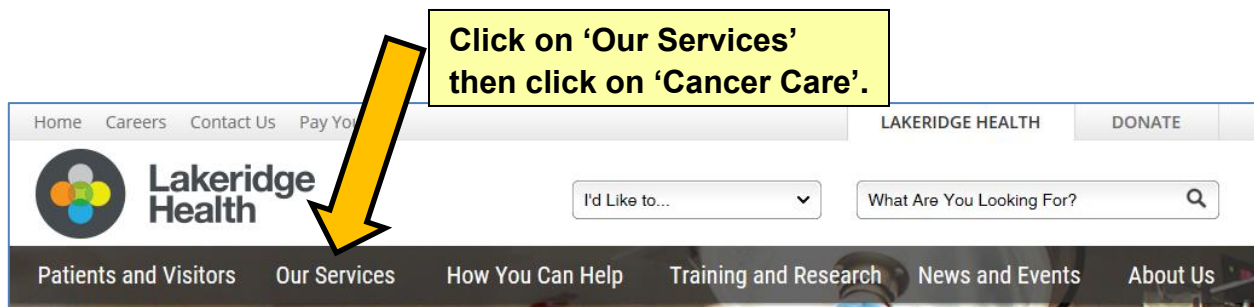


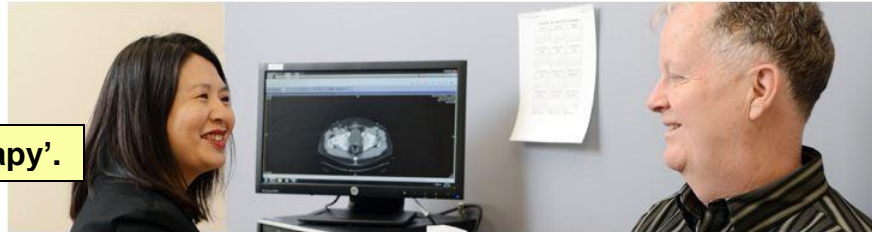

Once a diagnosis of cancer is confirmed, it's important that our health care team begin right away designing a treatment plan that is just right for you.

The three main ways to fight cancer include: the removal of tumours by surgery, and stopping or slowing their growth by using systemic or radiation therapy treatments.

Radiation Therapy is the treatment of cancer using radiation. Radiation is used to damage cancer cells. This can be done in different ways. Your radiation oncologist will talk with you about your choices for treatment. If you decide to have radiation treatment, your radiation oncologist and nurse will tell you what will happen next.

Your Radiation Therapy Team

Your radiation therapy team includes radiation oncologists, radiation therapists, medical physicists, oncology nurses, clerks, physics associates and service engineers as well as other healthcare professionals.
