

A Video Appointment with the Palliative Care Team

This handout offers you information on how to prepare for a video appointment with a doctor or nurse from the Palliative Care Team at the Durham Regional Cancer Centre. You will receive an email invitation to your video appointment with this same information. By accepting the email invitation, you consent (agree) to proceed with a video appointment with a doctor and a nurse.

Preparing for your video appointment

It is important you review this information 1-2 days before your video appointment to be prepared for it. You need to test your equipment before your video appointment. The doctor or nurse will not participate in this testing. If you have any problems with this testing, call our IT Service Desk at 1-866-338-1778 / 905-576-8711 extension 38326.

To participate in a video appointment, you need to use:

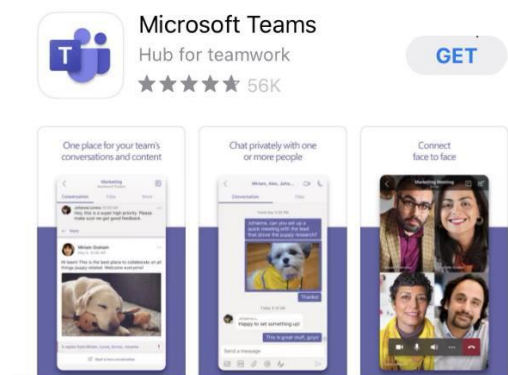
1. A computer that has both a webcam and microphone. You may want to download the [Microsoft Teams app](#) on your computer. **If your web browser doesn't support Microsoft Teams, you need to download one of the following web browsers ([Edge](#) or [Chrome](#)).**

Or

2. A tablet or smartphone. If you plan to use your tablet or smartphone, you need to download the Microsoft Teams app from your device's app store.



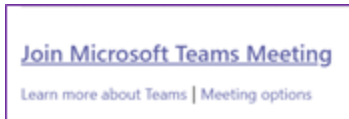

How to join your video appointment

1. 10 minutes before the scheduled time of your video appointment, click on the 'Join Microsoft Teams Meeting' link at the beginning of the email you were sent. The link looks like this:

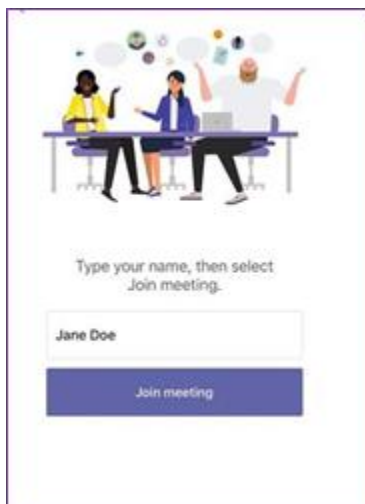


It is possible an urgent issue may delay your doctor or nurse from joining the video appointment on time. We ask you to wait up to 10 minutes past the scheduled start time of your appointment. If the doctor or nurse has not joined after 10 minutes, exit the video appointment. Call the secretary at 1-866-338-1778 / 905-576-8711 extension 33931 to reschedule your appointment.

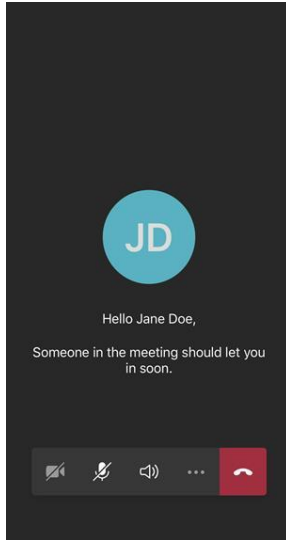
2. Click 'Join as a guest'



3. Type in your name then click on 'Join Meeting'.



4. You have now joined the call. You will see your initial(s) inside a blue circle.



5. Click on the camera and microphone symbols to turn them on. A line through the symbol means it is turned off. Both need to be turned on for your video appointment.
