



**Title: Purpose and Goals of the Central East
Prehospital Care Program (CEPCP)**

Category: 2.0 CEPCP Roles and Responsibilities

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The Roles and Responsibilities of the Central East Prehospital Care Program (CEPCP) shall consist of the following:

1. The Medical Advisory Board of CEPCP shall assume responsibility for the education and certification of Paramedics to deliver Controlled Acts.
2. Maintain Performance Agreements (PA) with each Upper-Tier Municipality (UTM) and designated Delivery Agent (DDA) responsible for the proper provision of Land Ambulance Services to provide medical directions and Continuous Quality Improvement Programs for the performance of patient care and maintenance of certification to perform Controlled Acts by the Paramedics employed by each UTM/DDA.
3. Delegate to Paramedics employed by each UTM/DDA to perform Controlled Acts outlined in the Provincial Advanced Life Support Patient Care Standards (ALS PCS).
4. Ensure that only physicians who have the proper credentials to work in the emergency department of the Host Hospital or any other hospital associated with CEPCP are utilized.
5. Ensure the provision of medical oversight of all patient care related issues affecting prehospital care.
6. Develop and implement a Continuous Quality Improvement Program.
