

# **Referrals to Oshawa Orthopaedic Fracture Clinic**

### Emergency cases - Immediate consultation with Orthopaedic Surgeon on-call

- Open limb fractures
- Multiple limb fractures
- Displaced and/or angulated fractures causing soft tissue complications and that cannot be corrected
- Unreduced dislocation or fracture in setting of previous arthroplasty
- Unreduced dislocations acute joint dislocation where ED or family physician is unable to reduce dislocation
- Suspected or confirmed compartment syndrome
- Acute infection of joint

## INJURY WITH VASCULAR COMPROMISE REFER DIRECTLY TO THE VASCULAR SURGERY SERVICE AT PETERBOROUGH REGIONAL HEALTH CENTRE AT 705-743-2121

### Next available appointment (up to 10 days)

- Paediatric fractures (within 5 days)
- Fractures and dislocations that were reduced in the Emergency Department
- Intra-articular fractures or fractures involving joint surfaces
- Occult fracture i.e., suspected clinically without radiological diagnosis (scaphoid, radial head, etc.)
