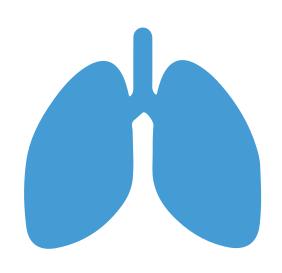
SHOULD I GO TO THE ER?

or tightness in the chest.



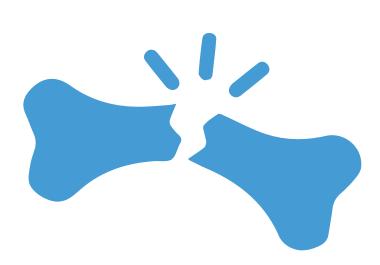
Confusion

Seizures

or convulsions



A broken bone

or a wound that needs stitches



Infant under three months has a fever over 38.5C

or 101F, or has a fever and is difficult to wake



Stiff neck

and sensitivity to light
