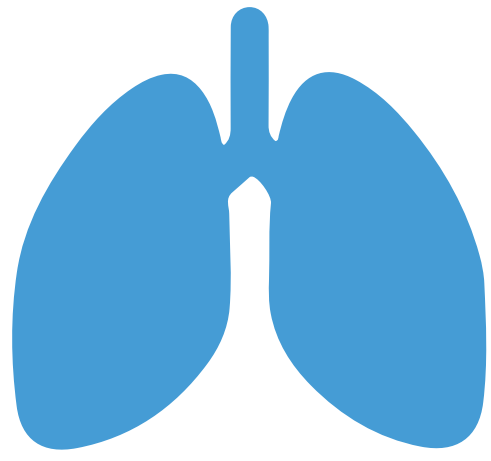


SHOULD I GO TO THE ER?

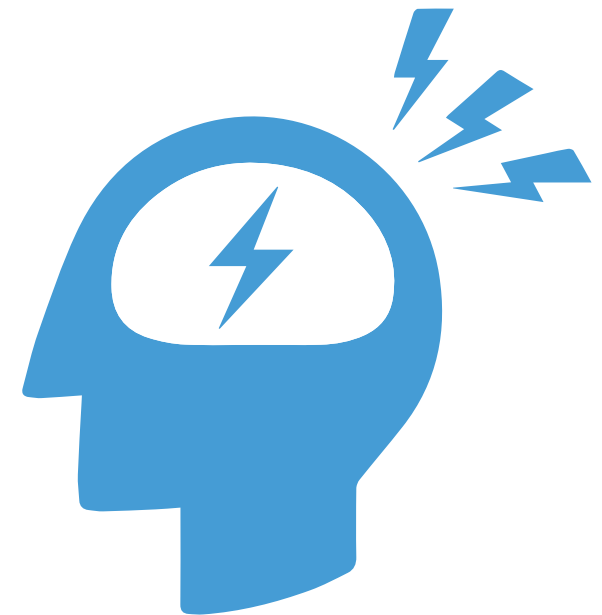
Our ERs are open ready to help you for these and other emergencies.

dehydration



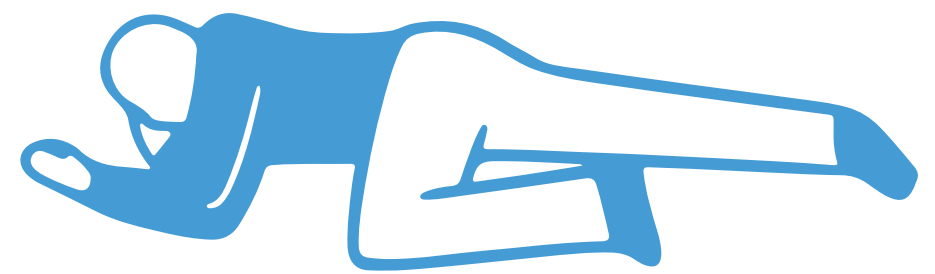
**Sudden severe

speaking, dizziness



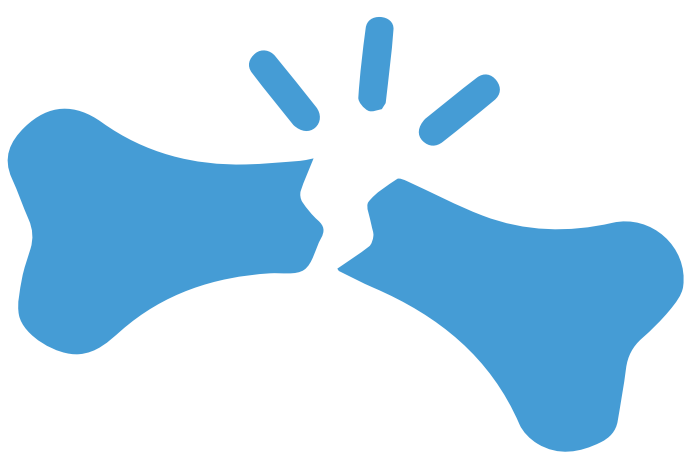
Chest pain
